### Explanation of Terms

The following terms are used in the athletic injury insurance proposal questionnaire:

Insurance Company:	The name of the <i>insurance carrier</i> (not the Agent or administrator) that was the <i>underwriter</i> for the policy.
Excess or Primary (E, P)	With excess insurance, the school policy pays after any other insurance policy which covers the athlete. With primary insurance, the school policy pays first.
Deductible (\$\$)	The amount that the athlete, school, or parents must pay before the policy begins paying.
(V)anishing or (C)orridor	With a vanishing deductible, amounts paid by the athlete's primary carrier are credited towards satisfaction of the deductible. With a corridor deductible, amounts paid by the athlete's primary carrier are not credited towards satisfaction of the deductible.
Aggregate Maximum (\$\$)	The maximum amount payable per injury.
Benefit Period (Weeks)	The number of weeks after the date of injury that benefits are payable under the policy.
AD&D (\$\$)	The amount of the death benefit under the Accidental Death & Dismemberment benefit of the policy.
Expanded Injury (Y,N)	Conditions normally excluded as not meeting the definition of an injury (e.g., tendinitis, bursitis, stress fractures, shin splints) are covered. Answer "Y" if this coverage was purchased.
Expanded HMO (Y,N)	On excess policies, claims denied by an HMO for failure to use a network provider are covered. Answer "Y" if this coverage was purchased.
Premium Paid (\$\$)	The annual premium paid for the policy year.
Claims Paid (\$\$)	The paid claims for the policy year.
Date Claims Paid To	The date that the paid claims information was generated. The more current this date is, the more useful the information will be.

For the paid claims and premium information, it is important to obtain carrier-produced reports. These should be available upon request to your Agent and/or carrier. This information is your property. Denial or delay in providing you this information prevents other carriers from offering competitive proposals.
